Please note that the appointment of Assistant Professor(s) in the University/conducted colleges/Institution is purely on contract basis and strictly only for the period from the date of joining to 30th April, 2019 on a consolidated pay of Rs.24,000/- per month. A person selected will not have enforceable right on the University for continuation in the succeeding academic session in any circumstances.
2. A person selected will be permissible to avail only 8 general leave during the academic session. No other leave and allowances are permitted to the person selected.
3. Candidates must read all the instructions before filling the application form in a prescribed "Format of Application" from the University website www.nagpuruniversity.org Candidates must ensure that no column is wrongly filled in Application form as the information furnished therein would be used for deciding the eligibility and suitability of the candidates for being called for the interview.
